Ephesians, written after Acts 28

After Acts, Paul received the truth of The Mystery, which up until Acts 28, had been hid in God.

After Acts 28 Paul received the dispensation of the grace of God. This includes redemption through His blood.

Dispensational truth hid in God, church his body

The Hope of our calling - heavenly places Incredible change from Acts 28 Eph.1:19-20 the exceeding greatness of his power to us.. according to .. his mighty power, wrought in Christ, raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places

Eph.2:5-6 .we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

But now. these redeemed called out people, have been raised and seated, where Christ is seated at the Father's right. **No Trumpet** No Isaiah 25 No Hosea 13 No O.T., no Law, no Moses, no prophet Raised to heavenly places

Corinthians and Ephesians were both written by Paul but must be kept separate. They have clear and obvious dispensational differences.

The fact that Paul received his truths directly from Christ before and after Acts, does not mean Paul's ministry during Acts was a progressive revelation or a gradual unfolding of the truths for today. Paul was not first in the Body at Acts 9 or 13, he and all believers at that time, were the vessels of honor, that elect remnant of grace of prophesy, preserving Israel. Their hope was Moses, the Law and the Prophets, our hope was hid in God, but we have the same Saviour.
