I heard a teaching about grace one time, and it made a big difference to me. "Experiencing the grace of God in a deeper way happens by learning about pure grace...no works, and if you truly believe it, God works in your life".

In July 2019 I responded to that message through a grief crisis occurring in 2017. I heard Bro J. preach this doctrine during an online church service from a "grace" right-dividing church. And a little later, 3 weeks perhaps, from another Bro. L.

Although that was 5 years ago, I felt others needed to hear it from me. I began hearing the word of God by studying my "mail," that is, the letters of the Apostle Paul, the Scriptures sent to me today as a Christian non-denominationalist.

These brothers taught Paul's letters for today were Romans through Philemon, 13 letters written by Paul our apostle about the dispensation in operation today. This was never preached at my Baptist, Assembly of God, or new life non- denominational church.

But God is working constantly in my life, and in August 2024 I learned from Bro.K. and Bro.L. to rightly divide Paul's letters. A bigger world of information and newer doctrines came my way. I latched onto it and it is sticking.

Praise God! The book, "The Appearing of Christ," triggered insights and truth. I saw Acts as a history of Israel and God's way to try to save more Israelites was by including Gentiles to provoke Israel to jealousy.

My main truth now is our program of pure grace started after Acts 28. Not popular with many but there are those like me who want more from our heavenly Father and to be grown up heirs of God.

So privileged to find his site Acts28.net.

It was just a year ago that I did not believe Bro.K. was correct and was told it is taboo—the Acts 28 doctrine... I stayed away from my sister trying to convince me to read his articles...not me---

So we can change, Amen. It happened in my case.

May we all listen to our mail to us---- the last 7 letters of Paul written after Acts 28.
